

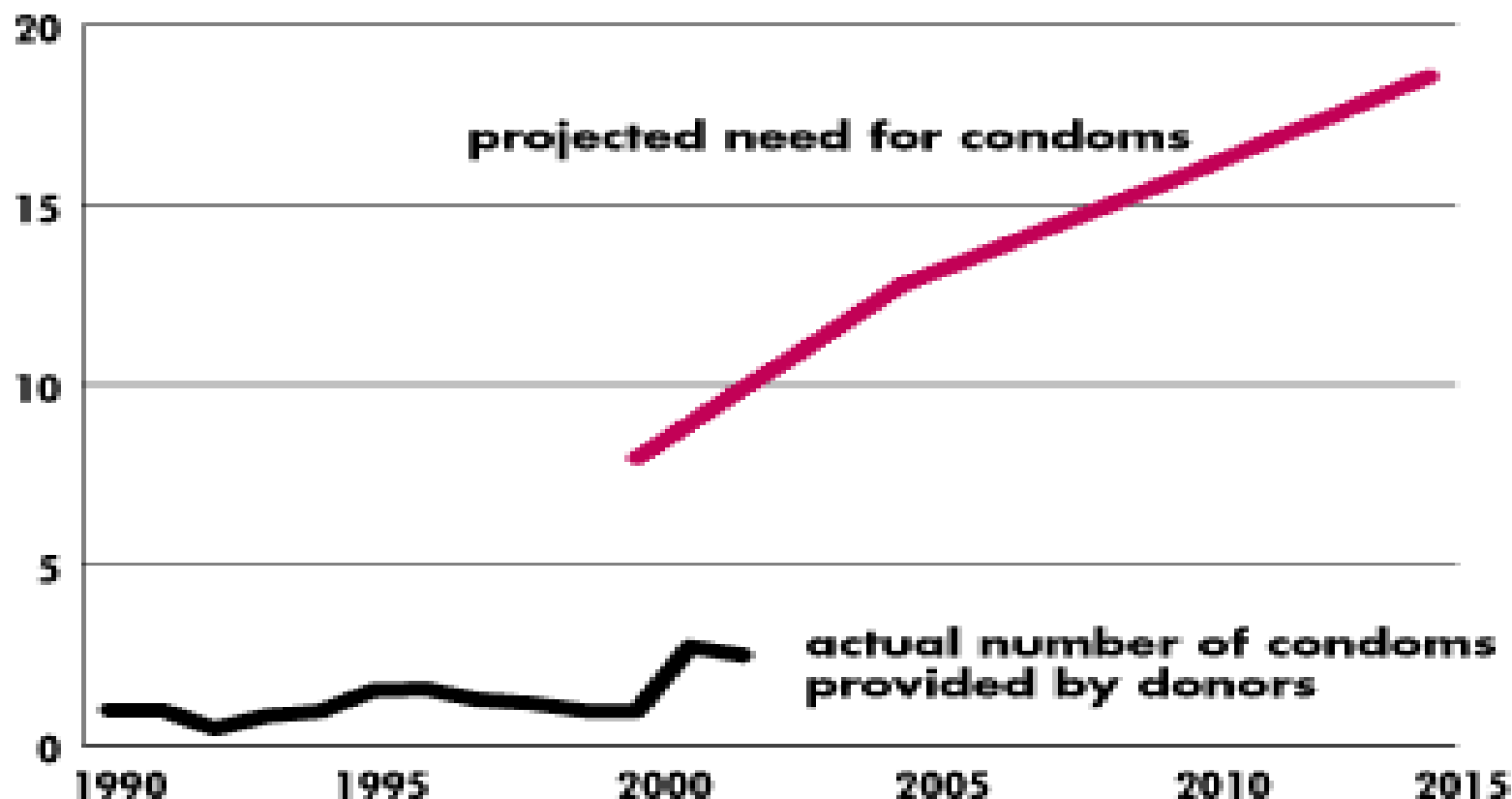

Who gets the condoms?

- Globally 1 male condom per man of reproductive age
 - 6 if your in Africa, 1 every two years if your in Asia
- Albania 20, Cambodia 9, Vietnam 2, Angola 4.5, DRC 1.75, Namibia 21
- One female condom per 20 women of reproductive age in Africa And 259,000 for the 800 million women in Asia
